Description of Position: This position is seasonal and is meant to provide work experience for the selected candidate and provide the ability to build your portfolio. This is not a full-time staff position. The chosen candidate will be required to attend all Windsor Spitfires home games and select special events.

Compensation: Volunteer position – with high school volunteer hours available or college/ university credit available upon consultation with your college/ university adviser.

Qualifications:

- Have an outgoing and engaging personality
- Experience in Adobe Photoshop & Lightroom
- Working knowledge of in-studio and location lighting
- Working knowledge of DSLR camera systems (Provide own equipment)
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail
- Ability to work flexible hours including Spitfires events and gamedays
- Recreational skating skills are a plus (not mandatory)

Responsibilities:

- Photographing team events, as well as “behind-the-scenes” opportunities around the arena and during games
- Help with editing photos through Adobe Creative Cloud software and other similar programs
- Photographing all home games for the Windsor Spitfires
- Act as fan photographer for special events and guest appearances
- Capture both action shots and crowd pictures to be used for marketing/social media
- Photograph sponsorship activation inventory to supply team’s proof of performance updates

Working Conditions:

- High noise levels during events
- Walking, stair climbing, and standing for sustained periods of time
